Information for people with a handicap



Information for people with mobility impairment

Entrance:

- Stepless entrance at the back of the Walhalla via ramps (gradient max. 6 %)
- The door is open during opening hours.
- A ramp for the threshold will be provided by staff if required.

Interior:

- · All important areas are stepless.
- No steps
- · Doorways at least 80 cm wide
- · Level, non-slip flooring
- Occasional seating available, portable folding stools can be borrowed on site



Disabled parking

There are two disabled parking spaces right next to the Walhalla. They are secured by a barrier and can only be accessed with a Euro key. The key cannot be borrowed on

site!

Please note: From the normal visitor car park, the Walhalla can only be reached via an approximately 700 m long gravel path with an incline or via a long flight of stairs.



Disabled toilets

In the public toilet behind the Walhalla. The disabled toilet can be opened with a Euro key; the key can be borrowed from the ticket office.



Information for the visually impaired

- No guidance system for the visually impaired available. An accompanying person is required for blind or visually impaired visitors! There are danger spots as there are no tactile boundaries around the building.
- Free app available (iOS; Android)
- No regular guided tours
- Behind the building near the wheelchair ramp there is a tactile model of the Walhalla.



Information for the hearing impaired

- No induction loop for hearing aids available
- Written information available at the location
